- MirrorBrain is a download redirector that organizes heterogenous mirroring servers
- MirrorBrain is highly scalable, secure and adaptable
- MirrorBrain is fully Open Source and licensed under GPL and Apache license
- MirrorBrain is a mature Open Source project in active development and in use since 3 years



- MirrorBrain automatically maintains the mirror network through monitoring, scans, mirror list generation
- MirrorBrain uses load-balancing for each request
- MirrorBrain uses geolocation and global routing data to optimize the use of the mirror network
- MirrorBrain facilitates reliable downloads by using Metalinks and P2P technology
- MirrorBrain works in the background to the user, it remains invisible























- Reasons why OOo was looking for a new download-management solution
  - Mirror-managing software didn't scale and ran into bottlenecks under load (e.g. release day)
  - Mirror-managing software picked a download location randomly from all mirroring servers, no geolocation
  - Mirror-managing software was isolated and abandoned with no development





### Mirror-managing software didn't scale and ran into bottlenecks under load (e.g. release day)



MirrorBrain has been handling the entire openSUSE mirror network for 3 years

That's 20B downloads without downtime\*

\* which wasn't caused by human error or hardware failure






### Problem: no geolocation for mirror selection

### Mirror-managing software was isolated and abandoned with no development



MirrorBrain has been in active development for three years, is fully open source, and is picked up by others



MirrorBrain has been in use across multiple organizations and content providers
